AGENDA PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2020-2021 TENTATIVE BUDGET AND PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE

1. Purpose of Meeting

The purpose of the public hearing is to receive input to the budget processes from the public and the Board of Commissioners. This hearing is limited to the budget process. We will accomplish the following in accordance with the State Statutes:

a) Discuss the percentage the proposed millage rate exceeds the rolled-back millage rate, if any.

b) Explain the reasons for the proposed budget.

c) Adopt a tentative budget.

2. Explanation of Budget and Millage Rate

a) Percentage increase in millage over the rolled-back rate necessary to fund this tentative budget, if any.

b) Define "rolled-back millage rate" -

Rate that would generate prior year tax revenues less allowances for new construction, additions, rehabilitative improvements increasing assessed value by at least 100%, annexations and deletions.

c) Explain specific purposes for which ad valorem tax revenues are being increased/decreased.

3. Comments and questions from the general public

4. Adoption of a Tentative Millage Rate

A tax of 0.5823 mills assessed valuation against the real and personal property within the Town not exempt from taxation by law, is necessary to raise sufficient revenues to fund the tentative budget, and said tentative rate 0.5823 of millage is hereby adopted subject to change at the second and final public hearing.

5. Adoption of a Tentative Budget

A tentative budget for the fiscal year beginning on October 1, 2020 as presented this date in the total amount of \$181,391,191 with an ad valorem tax of \$100,343 for operating purposes.

6. Announcement of final public hearing on September 28nd, 2020 Virtual Meeting 6:00 PM

The purpose of the second public hearing is to gather public input to amend the tentative budget as adopted this evening and to adopt a final millage rate and budget. This public hearing will be advertised as required by law.
