Treasurer's Report, Approval of Expenditures and Budget Worksheet:

Clerk/Treasurer, Barb Colucci went over balance sheet and P&L. Sheriff's Report

Corporal Duncan reported no crime in Belleair Shore for February. Commissioner Blume expressed concern over several ordinance violations happening near his home, most notably the electric bikes on the beach. Clerk was given okay to create a letter to be given to the local E-Bike rental places stating that these bikes are not allowed on Belleair Shore beaches as noted in our Ordinances. Clerk to finish by next week. Clerk to also distribute a complaint form to the Commissioners to use to funnel complaints to the Code Enforcement officer.

Pinellas County Permitting Services Interlocal

Counsel noted that this interlocal is good for our Town and that the charges that will be incurred will be charged to the resident for services by the County. She would also like to include our Flood Plain management on this interlocal agreement and will have that done within the next few months.
